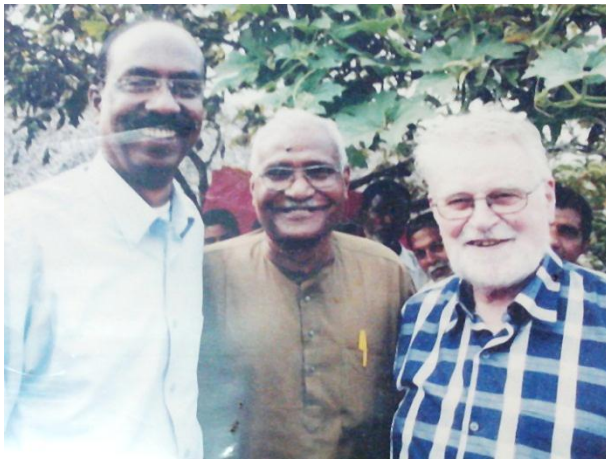
his life. "We are ever grateful to him for his great sacrifice." He added.
